Status of NSRP Panels for 2010

- **As the forecast for NSRP funding for 2010 is significantly improved, the ECB has indicated that the panels will be supported for full operations**
 - This will include the execution of Panel Projects, holding 3 Panel Meetings per year, active participation in the Ship Production Symposium and in ShipTech
- **The Systems Technology Panel has submitted two proposed Panel Projects for consideration by the ECB**
 - “Enhancing Product Model Data for Through Life Support” led by LSC
 - “Ship STEP Adoption Study” led by CTC
- **The ECB will review panel project proposals at its winter meeting planned for January 26, 2010**
- **A Research Announcement has also been issued for major projects totaling about \$10 million**
 - Abstracts for proposed projects were required by November 12, 2009 and those received have been evaluated by ATI and a grade (A through D) provided to the submitters
 - Technical and Cost Proposals are due to ATI by February 12, 2010
 - Project selection by the ECB is anticipated to be made on April 26, 2010

Strategic Investment Plan (SIP)
