



Product Design & Material Technologies Panel Meeting Alexandria, VA September 22, 2005

MEETING OVERVIEW

This PDMT Panel Meeting, which is being held on the day following (and at the same hotel as) the Crosscut Panel's Future Workforce ([Summit Crosscut Initiatives Panel webpage](#)), will be comprised of a half-day of technical presentations and a half-day PDMT Panel business session.

The technical presentations will include a final briefing by Bender Shipbuilding on the PDMT panel project titled "Internet Enabled Common Parts Catalog (CPC)," a final briefing by Atlantec Enterprise Solutions on the PDMT-oriented SBIR project "CPC Part Design Class," and a technical progress report on Bender's NSRP project titled "2nd Tier Shipyard Design Enhancement Project – Phase 2." The presentation portion of the program also includes two briefings from the Navy – one overviewing all ongoing SBIR and ManTech projects that map to the PDMT major initiative area, and the other a forward-looking perspective on Navy collaboration on future PDMT projects.

The business session of the meeting will address and provide a forum for attendee input to:

1. Topics and teaming opportunities for project proposals in the PDMT areas of interest. This discussion will address potential proposals in the PDMT area that are submitted in response to the next NSRP Research Announcement (RA), white papers submitted for consideration as PDMT panel projects, and proposals submitted in response to current and future Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR) solicitations keyed to the NSRP's Strategic Investment Plan (SIP).
2. Technology focus areas, schedules, and venues for future PDMT Panel Meetings and associated events. In particular, the discussion will solicit ideas for a possible NSRP-sponsored Design For Production (DFP) workshop in 2006.
3. Suggestions for future updates of the PDMT section of the NSRP's Strategic Investment Plan (SIP)
