Program Funding and Ops: 2007

- **FY 2007 Funding**

- **Appropriation for \$15M program funding has been signed into law and is making its way through DoD and NAVSEA**
- **~\$5 million from PEO Ships, Subs & Carriers has also been committed**

- **Separate contracting vehicle to apply any SCN funds from PEOs is still being worked**

Program Operations

- **Research Announcement (RA)**
 - RA issued in August, proposals submitted Oct 5
 - Technical Evaluation Review Panel (TERP) is being held this week in Charleston
 - Blue Ribbon Panel will meet in Charleston December 11 – 15 to develop and recommend a portfolio of projects to the ECB
- **Panel Project Proposals**
 - NSRP received a record response this year-- 25 out of a possible 27 project whitepapers
 - Whitepapers have been provided to the ECB for review...*panel members are urged to brief their ECB member on projects their panel is proposing and projects their yard is participating in*
 - *Panel Chairs will present project proposals to the ECB at Nov 9 selection meeting*
- **Panel/MITL Chair Meeting**
 - November 8 in Washington D.C.
 - Include discussion strategies toward regaining full program engagement by the shipyards to support significant increase in funding

Lean Shipbuilding & Ship Repair Forum

September 12-14 Jacksonville, FL

- **Overall, very positive feedback received**
 - speakers' enthusiasm and leadership was strong
 - provided actionable take-aways
 - great networking and sharing opportunities
 - New “Crackerbarrel” sessions proved valuable
- **Out of 90 respondents (136 total registrations)**
 - 91% indicated they would attend another Lean Forum
 - 58% said next year vs. 21% two years from now
- **Lean Implementers Group expressed desire for another Forum**
 - considering date and location options, likely 18-24 mos out

SMTC and Ship Production Symposium

October 12-13 Ft. Lauderdale, FL

- **18 Ship Production Symposium papers were presented representing 8 panel areas**
 - SPS sessions were well attended
- **Most presentations approved for PE credit**
- **NSRP booth at Expo**
