NSRP Mission

- The National Shipbuilding Research Program's mission is to employ a unique collaborative framework to research, develop, mature, and implement industry-relevant shipbuilding and sustainment technologies and processes, improving efficiency across the U.S. shipyard industrial base and meeting future demand.
- The NSRP's Government impact is primarily on U. S. Navy ships, but the program is also intended to benefit other Federal Government organizations such as the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), Maritime Administration (MARAD), Military Sealift Command (MSC), and Army Corps of Engineers (ACoE).
- The NSRP considers unmanned and optionally-manned vessels to be types of ships fully within the mission scope. The NSRP's mission equally includes reducing the total ownership costs of and delivering capability improvements to U.S.-flag commercial ships.

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

 - Do not discuss trade secrets or confidential information of your company or any other participant.
